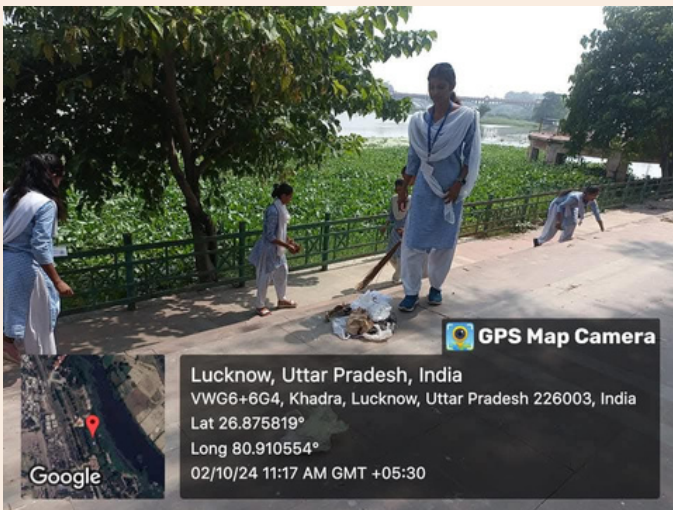


STEP TOWARDS AWARENESS
